He has published over 80 peer reviewed articles and has lectured at numerous national and international conferences. He currently teaches political science and the use of the military for the University of California at Berkeley, Dominican University, and Cal State East Bay Osher LifeLong Learning programs, and serves on the Board of the World Affairs Council of Northern California.

The last hundred years was clearly the "American Century." The USA become so powerful that it won two World Wars, came to dominate the global economy, powered tremendous innovation in science and industry, and promoted governance utilizing participatory democracy. Yet American democracy is now seemingly at war with itself: leadership has been eroded, institutions have been denigrated, there is a huge partisan divide, facts and truth do not matter to some, and we seem to have lost our mojo. B. NATURAL RESOURCES

- a. Iron and Coal from the Great Lakes Sped the Industrial Revolution
 - i. Stoked the world's heavy industries
 - ii. Iron + steel essential for a strong industrial base
 - iii. Bridges, railroads, buildings, cars, tools, etc
 - iv. Propelled the U.S. economy into the 20th century
- b. FOSSIL FUELS
 - i. First commercial U.S. oil well in Pennsylvania in 1859
 - ii. Large deposits found in western Texas, Panhandle, Oklahoma, and Kansas

- iii. Colossal reserves off the Gulf Coast of eastern Texas and Louisiana
- iv. And more eventually in Alaska
- v. Now FRACKING

The U.S. produced two-thirds of the world's oil during World War II This steady supply was crucial to the Allied victory

c. INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION

- i. Products were no longer made solely by hand but by machines
- ii. Shifted U.S. from an agrarian economy to a manufacturing economy
- iii. This led to increased production and efficiency assembly lines
- iv. lower prices, more goods
- v. Sped migration from rural areas to urban areas
- d. Coal + Iron = Steel / Steel + Commerce = Railroads
 - i. Improves Commerce
 - ii. Speeds further industrialization
 - iii. Then comes the California Gold Rush
 - iv. Leads to the Transcontinental Railroad
 - v. Communication follows the Railroad with the Telegraph
 - vi. Then comes the Panama Canal
- e. Roads Connecting America
 - i. The first macadam road was constructed between Hagerstown and Boonsboro, Maryland in 1823
 - ii. Each state in the U.S. built roads to serve its special needs
 - iii. (and special interests, haha)
 - iv. There were no uniform standards for size, width, grading
 - v. No uniform standards for bridges or tunnels
 - vi. The U.S. Army and General Pershing felt national security required better roads
 - vii. Sends LtCol Eisenhower to evaluate in 1919
 - viii. 62 days to drive across U.S.
 - ix. Later General Eisenhower becomes President
 - x. Interstate Highway System is born 1956
- f. Bridges
 - i. Brooklyn Bridge
 - ii. San Francisco Bay Bridges
- g. Dam the Rivers = Generation of Power
 - A. Hoover Dam
 - B. Tennessee Valley Authority
 - C. Rural Electrification Administration (REA)

Eligibility to vote in the U.S. is governed by the Constitution and grants the states the power to set voting requirements


